### It should not cost life to give life

In 2023 alone, around 260,000 women worldwide died as a result of complications from pregnancy or childbirth. We must significantly accelerate progress to meet global targets for reducing maternal deaths.

The far majority of maternal and newborn deaths are preventable if women have access to basic quality care during pregnancy and childbirth.

Maternity Foundation has documented and proven solutions, and to date has reached and supported more than 500,000 healthcare professionals worldwide. But the need is much higher and we have only just started.

### Partnership is key

Maternity Foundation is scaling up and have a target of ensuring 15 million safer births by end 2030.

Through our Global Maternity Partners Programme, we are partnering with a few key, global strategic partners to help realize our ambitious targets and accelerate our growth.

Global Maternity Partners consists of a small group of high-profile investors, each of whom shares our common goal - to ensure safer childbirths worldwide. They come from all around the world and represent a strong network of smart and inspiring investors, ready for change, each investing 150,000+ EURO per year for three or more years, and all of whom will become a fundamental part of Maternity Foundation's journey over the next three years and beyond.

Maternity Foundation's focus is on reaching and supporting midwives and other healthcare professionals in some of the world's most remote and fragile settings.

We do so by combining our evidence-based Safe Delivery App with hands-on training methods, thereby providing critical, life-saving learning to midwives and birth attendants.

Maternity Foundation has built a sustainable and cost-effective model, working together with partners such as UNFPA, UNICEF, Ministries of Health, Red Cross, and Plan International.
